Secrets of ageing gracefully

You may have a youthful face and a trim figure but your hands and neck can tell a different story. BONNIE ESTRIDGE finds out how to take years off your looks

SURGICAL SOLUTIONS: GO FOR GOLD

A SKIN rejuvenation treatment that can be carried out on any part of the body including the hands and neck is the gold thread lift.

The patient is given multiple injections of local anaesthetic in the area to be treated and the doctor gets to work with a 1mm gauge needle.

GP Dr Alexandra Chambers, who has a Harley Street clinic, has 10 years experience of carrying out the procedure in Russia and France and explains that a tiny thread of 24 carat gold is inserted just under the surface of the skin.

This stimulates increased production of the skin's support structure – collagen and fibroblasts around the gold in response to the presence of a foreign substance.

"New blood vessels appear when the healthy tissue begins to grow and this means the blood supply to the treated areas is increased, all of which should result in the skin becoming rejuvenated as it is firmer and

"Initial swelling disappears within a few days and a difference in skin texture can be seen in 10 days and will continue to improve, with optimum results at three months.

"Over five to 10 years, the fine gold sutures gradually become fragmented as they are broken down naturally." Cost: From £1,800

NOBODY can deny that Madonna looks fabulous at 50 but the bulging veins on her hands give her age away. According to vascular surgeon Josh Derodra of the London Day Surgery Centre, she's an ideal candidate for a pioneering new treatment to remove those telltale signs of ageing.

"For purely cosmetic reasons, it is possible to remove these veins without causing any long-term consequences to the venous circulation of the hands," he says.

A local anaesthetic is injected around the elbow to numb the hand area. A tiny needle is used to make punctures in the skin and the veins are teased and plucked out. This is a similar procedure to varicose vein

removal and takes around 40 minutes for one hand. "Stitches are not needed but the hand is put in a compression glove for three weeks to support the area and reduce swelling." he says.

Only one hand can be done at a time but once everything has healed up – which takes about two to three months – the other can be done.

GET A LIFT

THE ultimate anti-ageing treatment for a sagging neck is known as a platysmaplasty. The surgeon lifts the neck by tightening the platysma muscle, which extends from the lower jawbone all the way to the collarbone and spreads like a sheet over the deep tissues and bony structure of the neck. The skin is pulled up and the excess trimmed.

It is often done in conjunction with a facelift or liposuction. Scars are minimal as they are under and behind each ear lobe.

INJECTING Botox into the neck muscles can remove that stringy look. Botox is a purified, diluted version of the botulinum type A toxin and works by inhibiting the release of certain chemicals at the junction between a nerve and a muscle, so the message for the muscle to work is blocked and it therefore relaxes. "Radiesse is a newer typ of filler containing calcium hydraxylapatite, which is used medically ind also for dental augmentation.

TONING TREATMENT

SINCE it was introduced to the UK a few years ago, Accent has become a popular treatment for tightening loose skin on the neck.

It is a handheld machine that is shaped like a small hairdryer that works with two radio frequencies. One is used to heat up the skin's surface and another to penetrate the tissue under the skin, stimulating the production of new collagen.
